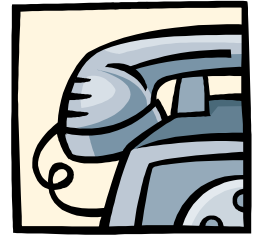


Pro Bono Opportunity: EMPLOYMENT Law Hotline



The Employment Law Hotline is a free service to people with basic employment law questions. There are many good reasons to volunteer for the Employment Law Hotline as a way to provide pro bono legal services to the community:

Convenient: The calls are forwarded to your office or home. Therefore, you can continue to do your work when you are not assisting callers.

Time Limited: Volunteers are asked to contribute up to 4 shifts per year. Each shift is 3 ½ hours. Women's Law Center volunteer attorneys staff the Hotline on Tuesday. On average, 5-8 calls are handled during a shift.

Rewarding: The Employment Law Hotline provides information, advice and referrals to individuals who may have no other access to a lawyer. The service provides callers with basic information to help them make informed and productive decisions about their situation.

Resources: Each volunteer is provided a comprehensive Employment Law Hotline Manual. This document provides: information about procedures for answering calls; short descriptions of substantive law; an extensive list of social service and lawyer referral resources for each county; and, information about local practice.

Experience Needed: Volunteer attorneys must have employment law experience.
