- ❖ ***Your Money Matters: A Guide to Financial Independence for Women:*** This publication provides practical information and tips to help women achieve financial independence at all stages of life. It also includes helpful tear-out planning worksheets.
- ❖ ***Legal Rights in Marriage and Divorce:*** This publication includes information about grounds for divorce, child custody and visitation, property distribution and alimony. Many attorneys keep multiple copies of this publication available to give to their clients. In addition to English, this publication is available in Spanish.
- ❖ ***Battered – What Can I Do?:*** This publication is geared toward the victim of domestic violence. It explains how to get civil protection, how to file criminal charges and safety planning strategies. In addition to English, this publication is available in Spanish, Korean, Chinese, Russian, Arabic and Vietnamese.
- ❖ ***Sex Discrimination in Employment:*** This publication describes the federal and state laws regarding sex discrimination and outlines steps to challenge the discrimination. In addition to English, this publication is available in Spanish.
- ❖ ***Legal Rights of Unmarried Cohabitants:*** This publication provides information about a range of topics relevant to a couple living together, including ownership of property, benefits and child custody issues.
