Child Custody Determinations

HB848 Family Law- Child Custody- Determinations

HB848 would codify the factors that courts use to determine the best interests of the child in custody cases. This bill will make it far more helpful to self-represented litigants because it will set out the factors that a court must consider when making a custody determination. The bill also requires the court to articulate its findings of fact on the record or to give a written opinion specifying which factors were considered in making the final custody determination.
