Dear Jessica,

Last week the Senate Budget & Taxation Committee (B&T) heard compelling testimony on <u>SB148 - Victim Services Programs - Supplementing Federal Funding and Support (Victim Services Stabilization Act)</u> from advocates across the state regarding the need for continued, stable Victim of Crimes Act funding through the Governor's Office of Crime Prevention, Youth, and Victims Services.

SB148 specifically addresses challenges victim services providers experience regarding federal funds administered by the State. VOCA funding supports services for crime victims all across the state of Maryland, including the WLC. Funds are used for services such as counseling, advocacy, domestic violence shelters, child advocacy centers, support for rape victims at the hospital, and victim-witness support in court. The WLC depends on VOCA funds to provide free attorneys to survivors of domestic violence in family law and immigration matters. Yet on-going challenges with funding and the inconsistent administration of the grants has put organizations that rely on VOCA funding in precarious positions. This legislation will ensure state funds to compensate for VOCA shortages and provide structural improvements to the administration of the grants.

We are incredibly grateful to the leadership of <u>Senator Guzzone</u> and for the advocacy of our sister-agencies, the <u>Maryland Coalition Against Sexual Assault</u> for leading the campaign and the <u>Maryland Network Against Domestic Violence</u> for representing service providers across the state.

Now I'm happy to report that the members of B&T not only voted unanimously in favor of SB148, but they all signed on as cosponsors, signaling their unified and strong support of the legislation. The next step is a vote on the Senate floor, which is expected later this week.
