Things are moving really quickly and so we once again have a list of asks of you. But this is a good thing! It means bills are moving and we need that to happen before the March 20th "cross-over" deadline!

Below I've listed out the updates and asks on some of our most important bills - from the Reproductive Rights Package of 2023 to the End Spousal Rape bill.

And once again, feel free jump to the good stuff below where I list out who to contact for which bills!

#### **REPRODUCTIVE RIGHTS PACKAGE OF 2023**

#### HB705 - Declaration of Rights - Right to Reproductive Freedom

Chair Pena-Melnyk did a phenomenal job defending this bill on the House floor. She successfully defeated multiple amendments and now the bill is set for third reader, most likely today.

Please take a moment to contact YOUR Delegate THIS MORNING and ask them to VOTE IN FAVOR of HB705!

#### SB798 - Declaration of Rights - Right to Reproductive Freedom

This bill was successfully voted out of the Senate Finance Committee and on second reader yesterday when it was laid over by motion until TODAY. Amendments can be introduced - and fought off! - today, and then it will be back for third reader. Call YOUR SENATOR TODAY and ask them to vote in favor of SB798!

Similarly, <u>SB341 - Public Senior Higher Education Institutions - Reproductive Health Services Plans - Requirements</u> was voted out of Committee and was also on second reader in the Senate yesterday. Please contact YOUR SENATOR TODAY and ask them to vote in favor of SB341!

The House Judiciary Committee heard <u>HB808 – Reproductive Health Protection Act</u> on Wednesday and we are so incredibly grateful that we had none other than THE ATTORNEY GENERAL on our panel to testify in support of this important bill. Contact the Committee and ask them to Vote Favorably on HB808. Meanwhile, also contact the Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee and ask them to Vote Favorably on SB859.

#### **Support for Survivors**

#### SB129 - Criminal Law - Sexual Crimes - Repeal of Spousal Defense

Sponsor: Senator Kelly/Secretary Lee (Judicial Proceedings)

The Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee heard incredibly powerful testimony just last night directly from victims who were sexually assaulted by their spouses, only to be retraumatized by the justice system that could not prosecute due to the marital relationship. Victims deserve more, and hopefully this is the last year anyone will have to endure this. Call JPR and ask them to vote in favor of SB129.

<u>SB36 – Family Law – Grounds for Divorce</u> It is now up to the Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee to vote on this bill that removes barriers for people seeking divorce and updates our laws surrounding the process. Contact the members of JPR and ask them to support SB36.

Finally, some exciting news!

HB3 - Maryland State Police Gun Center - Firearms Surrendered Under Final Protective Orders was voted out of the House this week! And it's cross-file, SB185, has made it to second reader in the Senate and is expected to make it through third reader! Thank YOUR elected officials for voting on this small but important bill!
