SJ1- Affirming the Federal Equal Rights Amendment



<u>SJ1</u> was a bill that the WLC presented written and oral testimony to the Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee. The bill has **passed** the committee with a vote of **9-1!!!** Please **contact your Senator** and urge them to support this resolution.

SB119- Legally Protected Health Care-Gender Affirming Treatment



<u>SB119</u> was passed by the Senate Finance Committee 7-3. The WLC of Maryland supports this important legislation because it protects healthcare workers who provide gender-affirming care from legal consequences. Please <u>contact your Senator</u> and urge them to support this legislation.

SB391- Criminal Law- Sexual Extortion, Stalking, & Revenge Porn- Removing the Statute of Limitations



<u>SB391</u> was a bill that the WLC supported and provided written and oral testimony. The bill has **passed** the committee by a vote of **44 -0**. This bill removes the statute of limitations on these specific crimes. Please <u>contact your Senator</u> and urge them to support this legislation.

SB50 Human Relations- Commission on Civil
Rights- Appeal of Final Orders




<u>SB0050</u> was passed the by the Health and Government Operations committee **45-0**. This bill will allow an appeal of a final order of the Commission on Civil Rights. The bill will go to the Senate for a full vote. Please <u>contact your Senator</u> and urge them to support this legislation.

HB1226 The Maryland Predictable Scheduling Act of 2024

creates the stability workers need to plan their lives. Some of the protections the law creates for workers include two weeks' notice of shift schedules, a right to decline last-minute additions or changes to scheduled shifts, and partial pay when shifts are canceled or cut at the last minute
